OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 Endorsed under secion 40

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the **Act**), **Three French Vines Limited** is authorised to sell alcohol remotely from (but not on) the premises situated at 18 Taranga Road, Langs Beach and known as "**Three French Vines**", to any person for consumption off the premises.

Section 40 of the Act applies to this licence; and the licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol from (but not on) the premises and deliver it to somewhere else.

CONDITIONS

- (d) The whole of the premises is undesigated
- (e) That no direct sales may be made at 18 Taranga Road, Langs Beach.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The sale and supply of alcohol is authorised in the premises situated at 18 Taranga Road, Langs Beach, or more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Whangarei District Licensing Committee on 2nd December 2016.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE

A copy of this licence must be displayed on the website so as to be easily read by people entering the website.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- (a) either—
 - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either-
 - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
